The venue for the April 21 to 26 meetings (for convenors and WG10) will be at the main office of Vattenfall, in the outskirts of Stockholm.

The hotel at Bromma is closer to our office, the hotel at Alvik is closer to the city centre. The general surroundings are somewhat nicer at Alvik, so my recommendation is to select that hotel for those of you who will stay over the weekend in order to participate in WG17 or 18 meetings the following week.

Please select the hotel and arrange the booking yourself, as soon as possible (within the next few weeks). You can reach the hotels by fax, e-mail or telephone. When booking, refer to TC57, in order to get the rates listed above, which are based on the Vattenfall discount.

Both hotels are located along the underground line called the “green” line. (The trains do actually go above ground most of the way to our office) When going to our office, you take trains going away from the city centre.

The trains should be marked with the destinations VÄLLINGBY or HÄSSELBY STRAND. Any train with a different marking going in the same direction will not go the whole way. You leave the train at a station called RÅCKSTA. There you will see a very large, white building beside the rail (absolutely can't miss it). The main entrance is in the centre building, you have to pass the building section closest to the railway.

You could of course take a taxi. It's a ten minutes ride from Bromma and approximately 20 minutes from Alvik. Give Vattenfall (at Råcksta) as your destination.
